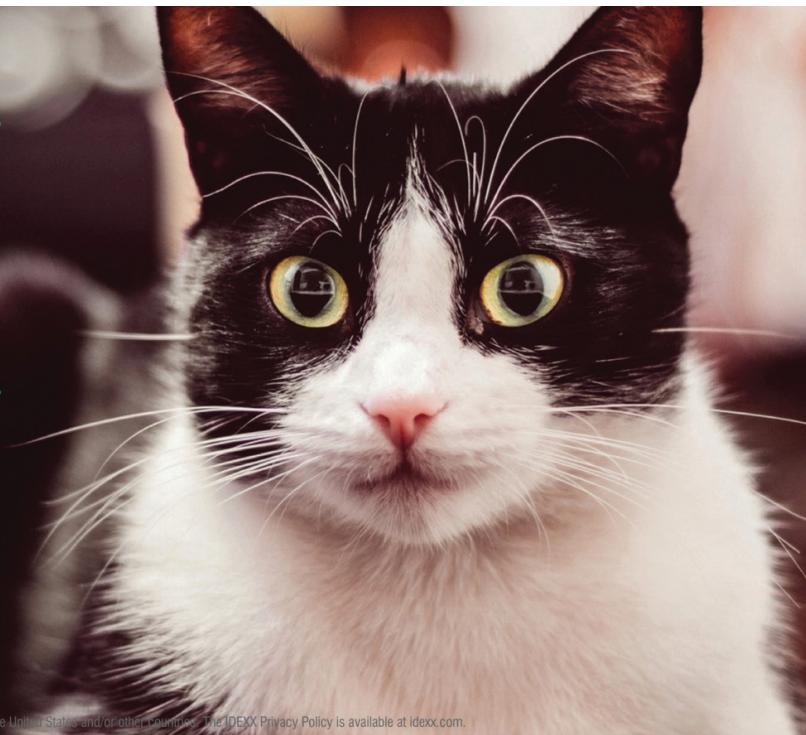

GETTING STARTED

Step 1. Download or Update the MVC App

Note: If you still have the mobile app from the 2019 MVC, skip to step 3.

1. Search for "Midwest Veterinary Conference" in the Apple or Android app store.
2. Tap the first result to download and install.
3. Open the app and search for **mvc2020**. (Note: This is also the event password. It is case sensitive.)

Step 2. Log In

The first time you open the app, you'll be prompted to log in. Doing so will allow you to take advantage of all the features of the app, including your personalized schedule, networking, and more.

1. Enter your first name, last name, and email address used to register.
2. Check your email for a verification code. Return to the app, enter the code, and tap Verify to confirm.

Step 3. Set Up Profile

1. Tap the "Profile" icon at bottom of home screen.
2. Tap the dots in the top right, then tap "Edit Profile."
3. Under "Profile Visibility," choose "Visible" to allow other attendees to find you.
4. Add the details you want to share and tap "Done" to save.

HOW DO I...**...CREATE MY SCHEDULE?**

- Tap on the "Schedule" icon at the bottom of the home screen.
- Select a day at the top to view the schedule. Find sessions by:
 - Simply scrolling through the list;
 - Typing a few keywords into the search bar; or
 - Tapping the Filter link at the top right and selecting the desired sort options. Tap Apply to see the results or Clear All to remove filters.
- To add a session to your schedule, tap the + sign to the right of that session. To remove it, tap the – sign.

Don't see the + sign? Double check your email; it **must exactly match** the address you used to register. If logging out and logging back in with the correct address doesn't fix the problem, stop by the Attendee Assistance counter.

...FIND MY SESSION ROOMS?

- Tap on the session you would like to attend.
- At the top of that session's page, tap the purple box to be taken to the room's location on the floor plan.

...NETWORK WITH OTHER ATTENDEES?

- Tap the "More" icon at the bottom right corner of the home screen.
- Tap the "Attendees" icon and type a name or keyword in the search box.
- Tap the attendee's name. From there, you can send a message, add them as a contact, set up an in-person meeting, and/or add private notes.

...RATE MY SESSIONS, SPEAKERS, AND THE OVERALL MVC?

- On the home screen, tap the "Share Feedback" button.
- All the sessions you've added to your schedule will appear here.
- Tap the event you would like to rate. If you don't finish or would like to change your responses, you can come back later.
