MOBILE APP QUICK-START GUIDE

Logging In

While not required, logging in gives you full access to the app, including the ability to view and modify your schedule, access session documents, network with other attendees, play the game, and more!

1. After downloading the event app (scan the QR code below), open it and type Midwest Veterinary Conference in the search bar.
2. Tap the download event icon icon to load the event.

Creating & Modifying Your Schedule

1. On the app home screen, tap the calendar icon in the bottom blue bar.

3. To register for additional sessions, tap on All Sessions at the top of the screen view the entire schedule and filter by track, speaker, etc.
4. Any changes you make to your schedule in the mobile app will be saved in your permanent registration record and be used to generate your CE certificate/transcript.

RABIES TITER TESTING

The CDC recommends veterinary professionals get either: (a) a one-time titer check one year after receiving the rabies vaccine series *and* up to three years following the first 2-dose vaccination OR (b) a one-dose booster between three weeks and three years following the first vaccine in the 2-dose vaccination.

- **When:** Friday, 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. No appointment necessary.
- **Where:** Outside the Exhibit Hall north entrance. (Near the Gathering Corner)
- **Cost:** \$98 for an antibody screen or \$118 for endpoint testing. Payments accepted include cash, credit card, or check payable to ARCpoint Labs.
- **Results** will be mailed directly to you within four weeks.


